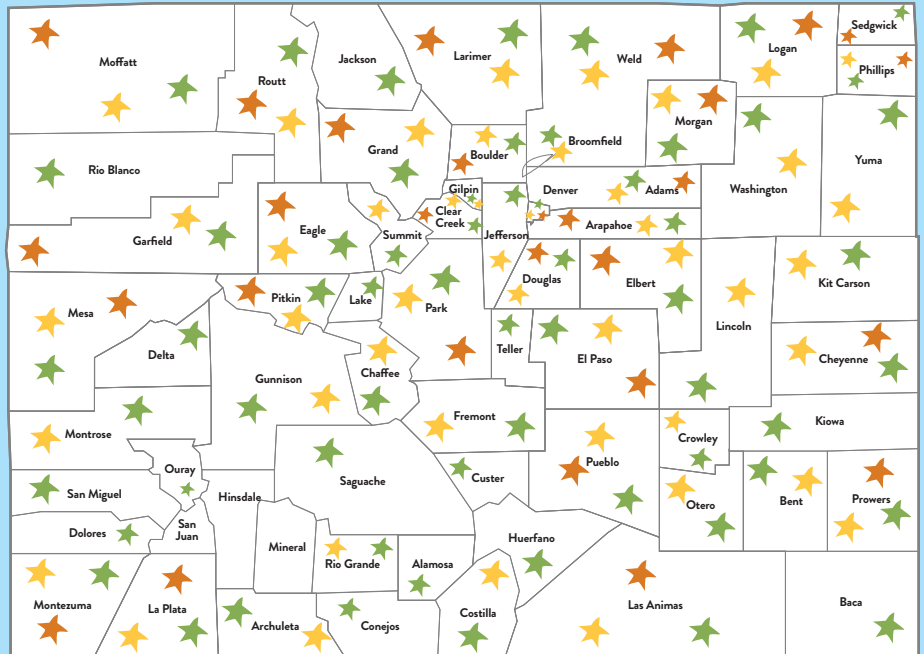

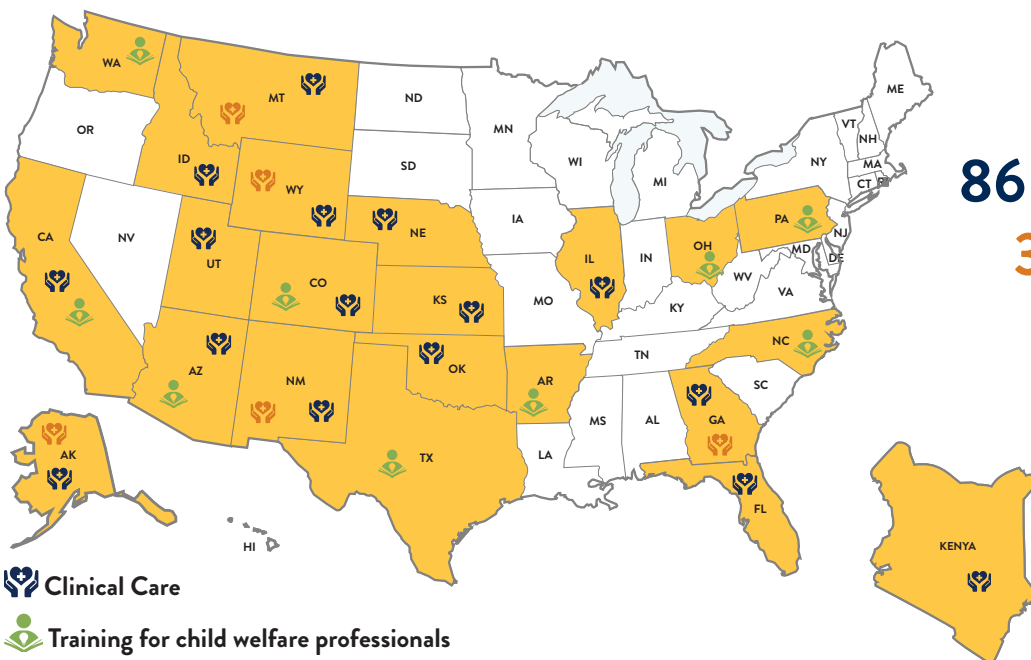

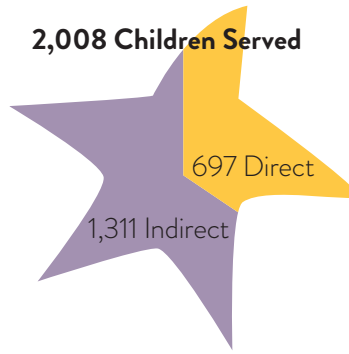

2,008 Children Served



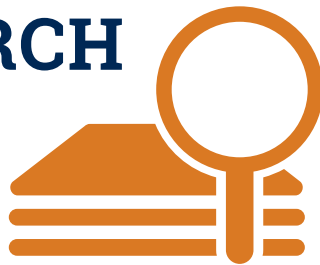
- **627 Adults Served**

# ADVOCACY

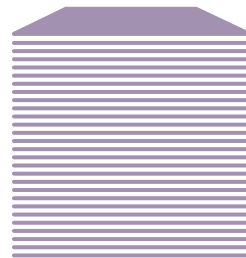
- Engaged in “Never Shake a Baby” and “Child Abuse Prevention Month” campaigns

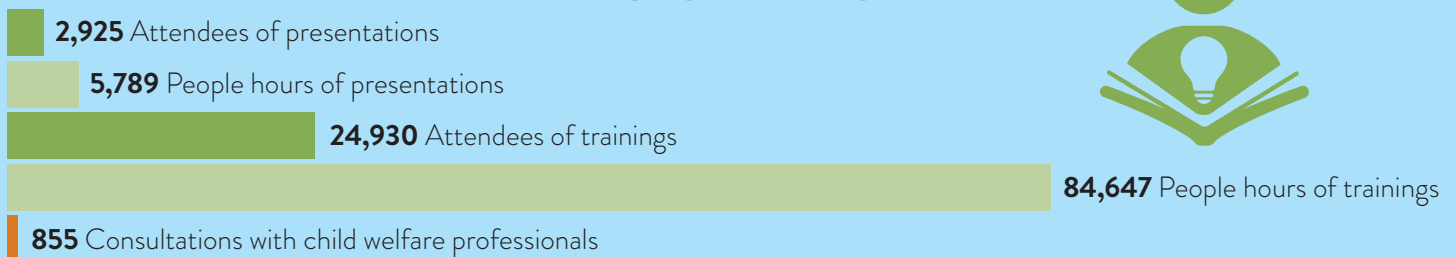
