OUR Keynote

Susan Payne is the Founder and Former Executive Director of the Safe2Tell nonprofit prevention initiative, developed as a response to the Columbine tragedy in Colorado. Ms. Payne, a 28-year law enforcement veteran, served in this role as a Detective from Colorado Springs Police Department; the first Special Agent with the Colorado Department of Public Safety, Homeland Security and she served as the Director of Safe Schools at the Colorado Attorney General's Office directing the Safe2Tell Colorado prevention initiative. She was recently appointed to the National School Safety Task Force and is an Expert Advisor to the Secret Service National Threat Assessment Center.

Ms. Payne has assisted many states in establishing best practice intelligence gathering and information sharing initiatives to focus on prevention and early intervention. She currently is an adviser and speaker for Safe and Sound schools. She trains on digital threat assessment for Safer Schools Together and serves on the National School Safety Consortium. The U.S. Department of Justice, The U.S. Secret Service and The U.S. Department of Education have recognized Ms. Payne as a subject matter expert in school safety, response, recovery and prevention strategies.
