

CWTS Annual Update

- CWTS leadership designed, developed, and launched a relationship coaching program, with primary focus toward race equity.
- CWTS training and coaching moved the needle for CDHS' goal of statewide Differential Response in 66% of Colorado counties becoming fully implemented, with an additional 14% of counties in progress.
- During COVID-19, transitioned CWTS to entirely virtual platform, conducting facilitation of all learning experiences online, while sustaining high-quality outcomes and learner satisfaction.

Spotlight: Coaching Evaluation

- Evaluation of CWTS' leadership coaching program confirmed new behaviors in child welfare leadership practices -- unanimously reported by leadership coaching participants.
- Participants highlighted enhanced confidence with decision making, more courageous communications, increased team cohesion and functioning, and a sense of reignited passion about their work.
